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What's New for 2021-22

The symbols NEW! and INFO! are used throughout the <u>Procedures Manual</u> to help call attention to new information or updates. These symbols are searchable.

- The NEW! symbol indicates changes or additions to policies and procedures for this year. The New for 2021–22 section in Chapter 1 of the Procedures Manual section also summarizes these changes, but it is important to read them in the context of the other information within the manual to understand the changes; chapter references are included to aid in this review.
- The INFO! symbol is used to indicate clarifications of existing policies and procedures throughout the manual; however, clarifications are not summarized in *New for 2021–22* section in Chapter 1 of the *Procedures Manual* as they must be read within the chapters to fully illustrate what has changed. Many of these clarifications are included to indicate policies and procedures that will be resumed after the extenuating circumstances from the last two years of test administration.

Pre-Testing Technology Coordinator Support for Test Administrators Webinar

Chromebooks and Chrome OS Auto Update Expiration (AUE) Policy (Repeat from July 14)

If your district has been using Chromebooks or Chrome OS devices for several years, the devices may be approaching Google's end-of-support dates in their Auto Update Expiration (AUE) Policy.

For ACCESS, consult DRC's Chrome OS Device Support, 2021–22, located in the WIDA AMS library of technical and test administration materials (No log in required. In the second paragraph under the first heading on the right side of the login page, select "click here (login not required)." On the Training Materials page, click the Show Documents button to display all documents; from the list of documents, locate and download the memo from June 22.)
