## Release of the Minnesota Questions Tool (MQT)

The Minnesota Questions Tool (MQT) is now available on the [Released MCA Questions](#) page of the Testing 1, 2, 3 website. A user guide is available for download on this page as well.

The MQT contains released test questions from past MCA tests, as well as links to data about each item. Educators can use these test questions to better understand how the MCA is aligned to the Minnesota K–12 Academic Standards, and how the items are written to reflect the rigor and complexity of the standards. The released content, data tables, and rationales can be used to explore examples of questions that evaluate the knowledge and skills expected in the standards.

More content for Reading and Mathematics MCA-III will be added by December and communicated in the *Assessment Update*.

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## 2021–22 Assessment and Accountability Results Release Timeline

In mid-February, MDE shared a standalone *2021–22 Important Dates* document with updated assessment and accountability reporting dates for all statewide assessments (ACCESS, Alternate ACCESS, MCA, and MTAS). It is

posted on the [Districts, Schools and Educators Statewide Testing](#) page of the MDE website (under the Testing Calendars expandable header), and on the [Policies and Procedures](#) page of the PearsonAccess Next website.

Note: The *Procedures Manual* was updated accordingly on Feb. 28. Ensure that you are using the most updated version of the *Procedures Manual* when looking for reporting dates for the 2021–22 assessment data.

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## ***Kindergarten ACCESS for English Learners***

This assessment is being refreshed to represent the WIDA English Language Development (ELD) Standards Framework, 2020 Edition. 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## ***Verifying Information in MDE-ORG (Repeat)***

### **DAC Assignments**

As MDE or Pearson may need to contact districts this summer, please ensure that the DAC contact information is current in the [Minnesota Department of Education-Organization Reference Glossary \(MDE-ORG\)](#). If the primary DAC is not available this summer, please add an Alternate DAC who will be available.

All contact information in MDE-ORG is updated and maintained by the district's Site Verification Coordinator (SVC). You can look up the SVC for your district in MDE-ORG. If the SVC has any questions about the process, they can contact [mde.school-verify@state.mn.us](mailto:mde.school-verify@state.mn.us) for support.

### **Shipping Addresses**

All addresses used to ship Individual Student Reports (ISRs) and student results labels (if indicated) will be populated from [MDE-ORG](#). Districts should verify the shipping addresses in MDE-ORG as needed **by July 14**.

- The Assessment Shipping address is a separate field in MDE-ORG that allows districts and schools to indicate a specific address where they would like test materials shipped at both the district and school levels.

- If there is no Assessment Shipping address present in MDE-ORG, the Location: Physical address will be used; if no Location: Physical address exists, the Mailing address will be used (but updates may be required as test materials cannot be shipped to P.O. boxes).
- If the Location: Physical address is the correct address to ship test materials, then a separate Assessment Shipping address does not need to be added for the district and/or each school.

If updates are needed in MDE-ORG, the district's Site Verification Coordinator must make changes in the [MDE District and School Site Verification system](#).
