Release of Test Results Summary

On Friday, July 29, District Assessment Coordinators (DACs) were informed in a direct communication that embargoed summarized assessment results have been released in Test Results Summary on [Secure Reports](#) page of the MDE website.

An American Indian state definition has been added to Test Results Summary for 2019, 2021, and 2022 data. The Minnesota Department of Education views the count of American Indian Students as defined by the state of Minnesota to be the most accurate and inclusive count of learners in grades K–12. The definition includes both students who self-identify as American Indian and students who self-identify as American Indian and a member of another racial group.

An updated version of the Test Results Summary User Guide, which provides information about the content and format of the reports, is posted on the [Assessment Secure Reports](#) page of the MDE website. If you had already downloaded the user guide prior to today, please discard the older version and use the one currently posted.

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Historical Growth Z-Score Data Leaving Academic Rosters August 8

Beginning on Monday, Aug. 8, the [academic rosters](#) (MDE home page > Data Center > Secure Reports > Academic Rosters) in Accountability Secure Reports will no longer contain students' growth z-score data. These changes will occur at the same time as the 2022 accountability files become available, and they will affect all files.

Schools and districts who want to preserve their historical growth z-score data are encouraged to download the current versions of their academic rosters for desired years prior to August 8.
