ACCESS Training Registration

In late November, professional development staff from WIDA will conduct in-person ACCESS trainings. These trainings allow participants to ask questions and learn more about the test preparation and administration process, but they do not replace the required Training Courses on the WIDA website.

- ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 Test Coordinator Training is intended for District or School Assessment Coordinators
 who will set up user accounts, prepare for online testing, and verify staff have been trained.
- Kindergarten ACCESS for ELLs Test Administrator Training is intended for educators who will administer the Kindergarten ACCESS, a one-on-one paper administration, for the first time this year.

Each training is a half-day session. If space is no longer available for your preferred date and time, it will be closed, and you will need to select another date or time. Please do not register more than three people from a district or charter school in any session. SurveyMonkey, the application used to gather registrations, does not provide automatic confirmation emails. In mid-November, MDE will send a confirmation reminder to the email address used to register.
