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## Entering Reimbursement Requests in GRR

Districts who have received assessment results for the college entrance exam they administered (ACT or SAT) should enter requests for reimbursements in the [Graduation Requirements Records \(GRR\) system](#) for eligible students (MDE website > Districts, Schools and Educators > Business and Finance > Data Submissions > Graduation Requirements (GRR)). If a district has not previously received reimbursement for a student, the following criteria applies to reimbursement requests for 2018–19:

- Districts will be reimbursed for students eligible for a free/reduced-priced meal (FRP) who are entered into GRR.
- Districts may also be reimbursed on a prorated basis (if necessary) for students who are unable to pay for the exam. Districts must determine the criteria for unable to pay and enter those requests into GRR.

Districts are to submit eligible grade 11 and 12 reimbursement requests no later than Sept. 13.

### Reimbursement Reports

After districts enter reimbursement requests in GRR, they must confirm that the students for which they expect reimbursement are included in the reimbursement reports, which are refreshed each morning.
