District Testing Calendar

Districts are required to post a comprehensive testing calendar on the district website before the first day of the school year; this information may also be posted on school-level websites if the district chooses. Districts may choose how to display the information (e.g., in a chart, a calendar format), but it should be presented in a way that is as easy to access as possible. Core requirements for the district testing calendar have not changed and are detailed in the <u>2018–19 Procedures Manual</u>, starting on page 125 (PearsonAccess Next > Resources & Training > Policies and Procedures).

PearsonAccess Next Reports: Preparation for 2019 Results

In preparation for loading the MCA and MTAS 2019 final results in PearsonAccess Next, Historical Student Data and Longitudinal Reports will be unavailable from Aug. 5–28 in PearsonAccess Next. All Longitudinal Reports and Historical Student Data will again be available—along with the 2019 results—on Aug. 29.

On-Demand Reports and Reporting Groups for 2019 preliminary results will be removed on Aug. 29, which is when districts will receive their Individual Student Reports (ISRs) shipment and when 2019 results will be available in Published Reports in PearsonAccess Next.
