

Instructions for Mathematics Table Accommodations

Multiplication and hundreds tables are allowed as an accommodation for students who have these tables indicated in their IEP or 504 plan for the Mathematics MCA. These tables must be the printed versions from PearsonAccess Next.

- For grades 3–8, these accommodations require the student to test using a paper test book in an individual setting and only use the tables on the segments where calculators are allowed (Segments 2, 3, and 4).
- For grade 11, since a calculator is allowed on all sections/segments of the grade 11 Mathematics MCA, the student may test online or with paper test materials, but must test in an individual setting.
 - Note: Using these mathematics tables is considered a universal support for grade 11 Mathematics
 MCA and their use is not indicated with a code for MDE.

Test Administration

Test Monitors or other district staff may not provide other versions of a multiplication table or hundreds table; only the versions on PearsonAccess Next may be provided.

If students use the same table(s) for instruction and testing, Test Monitors must ensure that they do not have any additional writing on them before they are used for testing. If they do, a clean copy must be provided. The table(s) must be collected at the end of each test session and kept as a secure material, as students may have written parts of test items on them. Following test administration, the tables must be securely disposed of.
