## Testing Terminology: Words of the Month

- **WIDA AMS (WIDA Assessment Management System)** – WIDA AMS is used for setting up and administering online tests, ordering paper and accommodated test materials, and managing student data for ACCESS and Alternate ACCESS for ELLs and the WIDA Screener.
- **EL (English Learner)** – Programmatic and research term used to identify students learning English as an additional language. May also appear as ELL – English Language Learner or LEP – Limited English Proficient.
