

## New Recommendations for Proctor Cache

---

Pearson has updated Proctor Cache recommendations for the 2018–19 school year and beyond because of the increased bandwidth now available in schools throughout Minnesota and nationwide. In addition, Pearson has made significant updates and improvements to TestNav, which reduces the overall bandwidth required to test successfully.

- However, Pearson is still recommending Proctor Cache for the Science MCA and Science Script MCA tests since they are not adaptive and are large in size due to simulations and animations.
- Proctor Cache is no longer recommended for Reading or Mathematics MCA tests, which due to their adaptive nature, require continual communication with Pearson servers. Most school districts have ample network capacity to support adaptive testing without the need for local content caching.
- Proctor Cache is also no longer recommended for any Data Entry Tests.
