




Navigation Teacher Guide

This guide provides educators with details on the navigation students experience in the Navigation Tutorial and on the MCA. Educators may also access the [Navigation Tutorial](#) (PearsonAccess Next > Preparing for Testing > Student Tutorial) to familiarize themselves with it before using the tutorial with students.

Standard text-to-speech is available if students need audio support for the text in the Navigation tutorial. For some navigation features, students will need to scroll down to practice using them. A written reminder for students to be sure to scroll down to the bottom of the page will be displayed.

This tutorial outlines how students will move through the test. While the functionality is similar, there are some differences between adaptive tests (Reading and Mathematics MCAs) and fixed-form tests (Science MCA) that are addressed in this guide.

<p>Information on the Gray Bar</p> <p>The gray bar has information about the test and number of questions that students can reference during testing.</p> <p>For Reading and Mathematics MCAs:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Items (and for reading, passages) are divided into multiple groups. • However, no group numbers appear in the gray bar. Even though the test is broken up into multiple groups, TestNav sees the entire adaptive test as just one section and cannot show which group of items a student is on. • The question number shows the number of questions in the entire test. <p>For Science MCA:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The items and scenarios are divided into two sections that are roughly equal in length. • Because the text is a fixed form and items are pre-selected, the gray bar indicates which section the student is in (Section 1 or Section 2). The question number shows the number of questions in each section, not the entire test. 	<p>Reading and Mathematics MCA</p>  <p>Science MCA</p>

<p>Student Directions</p> <p>Student directions are the first section of each test. These directions appear after students sign in and before they begin each test. Text-to-speech is available for these directions in all subjects.</p> <p>The <i>Testing Directions: Online</i> contains a transcript of these directions. A transcript and screenshots are also provided in the <i>Overview of Student Directions</i> document for reference. Both documents are available on the Testing Directions page (PearsonAccess Next > Preparing for Testing > Testing Directions).</p> <p>Note: Once students select the Next button in the directions, they will not be able to go back to previously viewed directions pages. In addition, once they navigate past the directions, they cannot go back to them.</p>	
<p>Moving Forward and Back</p> <p>Students use the Next and Back buttons to move forward and back in the test. However, they must answer the question before they can select the Next or Back button.</p> <p>Some questions have multiple parts and students cannot select either button until they have answered all parts.</p>

Questions Where Students Need to Scroll

Some questions will not fit on the screen. Students must scroll to see the whole question by dragging the scrollbar up or down.

For reading, students will see a split screen showing the passage and the question. The passage is repeated on the left side of the screen, and the question and answer choices are shown on the right. Students may need to drag the scrollbar to see the entire passage or question.

For science, students will see a split screen showing the science scene and the question. The science scene is repeated on the left side of the screen and the question and answer choices are shown on the right. Students may need to drag the scrollbar to see the entire scene or question.





Title Pages (Reading and Science MCAs only)





At the beginning of each reading passage or science scenario, students will see a screen with the title of the passage or scenario.



For reading only, students may see two titles on a title page. This means there will be two passages that go with the next set of questions.


Note: Title pages are not included in the Navigation Tutorial. Refer to the item samplers to see the content-specific format of each test, as needed.

<p>Students Reviewing Answers</p> <p>The Review button lets students go back to questions to review their answers. After students answer a question, they can see items they have completed by selecting Review. However, if the question is not answered, students cannot select Review.</p> <p>Note: In the Navigation Tutorial, students are able to review or go to all questions throughout the tutorial. However, when students select Review in their test, it will only show the questions they have already answered.</p> <p>The number shown on the All Questions tab of the Review list tells students how many questions they have answered.</p> <p>The number shown on the Not Answered tab of the Review list will always display as zero in the test since students must answer the question before they can select the Next or Back button or Review.</p>	
<p>Students Bookmarking Questions</p> <p>The Bookmark button lets students mark questions they want to review later.</p> <p>When students select Bookmark, a blue bookmark appears next to the question on the Review list.</p> <p>The number shown on the Bookmarks tab of the Review list tells students how many questions they have bookmarked for review.</p>

<p>Reaching the End of a Section</p> <p>After students have answered all the questions in a group of questions or a section, they will see a Review screen. The Review screen is different based on the test students are taking.</p> <p>Specifically for the Science MCA Review screen, students can also select the Bookmarks icon and then select a bookmarked question to go directly to the question.</p> <p>For all tests, students can select Review and then select any question to go back to and review their answers. When students are done reviewing, they can select Review and select End of Group/End of Section at the bottom of the Review list to go back to the review screen.</p>	<p>Reading and Mathematics MCA Review Screen</p>  <p>Science MCA Review Screen</p>  <p>Science MCA Bookmarks Icon</p>  <p>Review Questions (all tests)</p>

<p>Going to a New Section</p> <p>The way in which students go to the next group of questions or section also varies based on the test students are taking.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For the Reading and Mathematics MCAs, students use the Next button to automatically go to the next group of questions. For Science MCA, students use the Submit button to go the next section. A warning will pop up. Students select No to go back, or they select Yes to go to the next section. <p>Once students go on, they cannot return to items completed previously.</p>	<p>Reading and Mathematics MCA</p>  <p>Science MCA</p> 
<p>Exiting the Test</p> <p>To exit the test, students will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Select the button next to their name. Select Sign out of TestNav in the dropdown menu. Select Save and Return Later.

<p>Inactivity</p> <p>Student tests in TestNav will time out after 20 minutes of inactivity. Inactivity is defined as not touching the screen, moving the mouse, and/or pressing keys.</p> <p>Students will receive a warning 30 seconds prior to being exited due to inactivity. When they are exited, they will also receive a message that the session (i.e., their test) has closed due to inactivity. The student's test will need to be resumed in PearsonAccess Next in order for the student to continue testing.</p> <p>If students are exited due to inactivity, they still have 20 minutes to resume the test with the ability to go back and review. If more than 20 minutes have passed, students cannot go back to review their answers.</p>	<p>Warning Message</p>  <p>Exited Message:</p>

<p>Completing the Test</p> <p>When students have completed their test they will see a final Review screen. The Review screen is different based on the test students are taking.</p> <p>To submit their test:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For the Reading and Mathematics MCAs, students will select Next. Once students select Next, they will not be able to go back to their test. Then, students will select Submit Final Answers. For Science MCA, students will select Submit Final Answers.
