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#### **DSR/SSR Update**

Final student-level ACCESS, MCA, and MTAS <u>District and School Student Results</u> (DSR and SSR) files now include updated demographic data for districts and charters who completed the appeals process for state identification of American Indian students. Don't forget that these results will be under embargo until the public release of assessment results on Aug. 29.

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# New Guidance on Administering WIDA Screener to Students who are Blind/Visually Impaired and/or Deaf/Hard of Hearing

A new guidance document is available to provide WIDA's recommendations for IEP/504 plan teams to consider when administering WIDA Screener to a student who is blind or visually impaired (BVI), or who is deaf or hard of hearing (DHH). It includes general administration guidance, specific considerations for students who are BVI or DHH, and a short list of resources for more information.
